NOHS PTSA Committee Descriptions

Academic Boosters - Originally, an independent group to recognize academic achievement, now a part of PTSA

Bake - Provide bakery for September Open House, Staff Appreciation Luncheon, Hospitality and when needed

Bookstore - Sell school supplies and books. Open during lunch, twice a week. If there are enough volunteers interested, bookstore will open in morning before school starts.

Community Event - Help organize, set-up, greet, serve food, clean up, etc. Currently, the Health Fair (in February/March) is the Community Event.

Cultural Arts - Help with our entries to the National PTA Reflection contest (Art, Dance, Film, Music, Photography, and Literature) and any other art activities.

Health, Welfare, and Safety - Help with ideas, programs, and distributing literature relating to these topics

Honors Breakfast - This is an Academic Boosters Committee activity, rewarding students of academic achievement with a breakfast in January.

Hospitality - Help set-up, clean up, and serve refreshments at Open House and other events.

Just Ask - Help when the school asks or the PTSA needs volunteers

Market Day - Help at Market Day Pick-up Day, sorting, filling orders

Ohio PTA District 11/12 Conference (this year only) - North Olmsted PTA Council is hosting event on Oct 22 at High School. Help set up, clean up, direct to classes, etc.

Public Relations - Promote PTSA at school and the community; morning announcements, school sign, newspaper, etc.

Scholarship - Review scholarship applications, not open to parents of senior students. Must be familiar with PTSA requirements, by-laws, etc.

Staff Appreciation - Help at Staff Luncheon, etc. to show our appreciation of the High School staff

Underclass Honors Ceremony - This is an Academic Booster Committee activity in May. Check in students, etc. the evening of event.

Volunteers - Help co-ordinate volunteers and make reminder calls, help track volunteer hours

Ways & Means - Help with fundraisers (other than Market Day)
