The purpose of this form is to direct your attention to your art class, and how your grade is assigned to you. There are several factors that contribute to your grade.

1. Each art lesson that is presents has some **objectives** that are discussed and demonstrated during the directions at the beginning of the class. *The objectives are always emphasized*, and are usually two or three. The objectives are always important to be included in your work.
2. **Neatness** is *always* an important factor to be evident in your work. Backgrounds should be completely filled- in when coloring. Scribbling is **NOT** accepted. Students should not hurry through an activity, and apply little or no effort, therefore having sloppy work.
3. **Effort** should be applied to do the best you can. You don't have to be an artist to do good work. *Follow directions and keep on task.*

Keep to Yourself and do not distract someone at your table. Excessive talking is disrupting and is not productive. If you waste your art time you cannot be finished in the allotted time for each activity. Show respect for your own work, and for others.

The above rules apply to receive an "A" in Art.

Mr. Johnson always gives you enough time during each art class to do your activity. It is up to you to use the time wisely. Mr. Johnson will move around the room and observe each student several times during the class period. When a student is finished with an activity, a grade is recorded at that time for the student's product and effort.
