The Model Classrooms Project (MCP) is in the second year of implementation for the district. The MCP focuses on six strategies: ***content, thinking, product, assessment, facilitation, and reflection.***

Teachers and administrators have been working together to develop the classroom instructional practices that will increase the levels of student academic progress.

The Model Classrooms Project provides a focused plan to build the infrastructure needed to make the necessary changes in the classroom that will raise the bar for all students.

The MCP teaching strategies that are put into practice in the classroom are documented using digital media to record “vignettes.” These “vignettes” of successful practices are then shared throughout the district.

The intense staff training and constructive feedback is helping North Olmsted teachers plan and implement lessons that will help their students attain higher levels of academic achievement.
