The meeting was called to order, and the roll call was taken. The Board Members present were: Mike Raig, John Lasko, Terry Groden and Tom Herbster, and Joanne DiCarlo.

Under Announcements:

Vera Brewer introduced State Representative Nan Baker (House District 16) who presented the district with a Proclamation on earning the State's highest ranking of Excellent with Distinction on the State Report Card for 2009/2010. The Proclamation recognized the district for "leadership and foresight in providing students with the best possible education" and reinforced that "education is vital to our nation's continued economic and social well-being, and as the need for global learning and understanding increases, so do the demands placed upon our system of education."

Under Recommendation of the Treasurer:

The Board approved the following: Financial Statement and Payments for November 2010; The Modifications to the 2010-2011 Annual Appropriations; The 2010 tax year rates as determined by the Cuyahoga County Budget Commission and authorization of the necessary tax levies to be certified to the Cuyahoga County Auditor; Medical Mutual Service/Flex-Save Contract and a donation of Elementary level books from Denise Ressler.

Persons Discontinuing Employment:

The Board approved the following: **1-Resignation:** Leigh Ann McHenry, High School Tutor, effective November 30, 2010 for personal reasons; **2-Medical Leaves:** Nicole Lynch, Parent Mentor, from October 1, 2010 until released by a doctor to return, without benefits but with pay through November 17, 2010 and Renee Ringwall, Bus Operator, from November 11, 2010 until released by a doctor to return, without benefits but with pay through November 19, 2010; **1-Supplemental:** Cheryl Bede, High School Foreign Exchange Club Co-Advisor.

Persons Beginning Employment – Certified:

The Board approved 1 reserved teacher, at the established rate, as needed, for the 2010-2011 school year.

Persons Beginning Employment-Classified:

The Board approved 2 substitute positions, at the established rate, as needed for the 2010-2011 school year.

Employment Contracts – Other:

The Board approved the employment of Barbara Chadwick, certified employee as a Title I Math Tutor for Maple Intermediate, paid at the current tutor rate, for up to 75 hours from November 16, 2010 through May 20, 2011.

Supplemental Positions for the 2010-2011 School Year:

The Board approved the following: 5 advisors, coaches, mentors, etc., filled by certified personnel contingent upon sufficient student participation and 2 supplemental positions filled by classified personnel, per the Resolution, contingent upon sufficient student participation.

Persons Changing Supplemental Positions:

The Board approved Darlene Matthews, from Co-Advisor High School Foreign Exchange Club, to Advisor.

Stipends/Other Compensations:

The Board approved the following: Payment, at the current tutor rate, to Eileen Andrews for one hour for review of the Ohio Achievement Assessment results data on October 19, 2010; Payment, at the current classified staff training rate, to 6 classified staff for their attendance at the Licensing In-service Training for Preschool staff held in August, September and October, 2010 and presented by the Ohio Department of Education Office of Early Learning and School Readiness; Payment, at the current tutor rate for 9 hours, to Terese Medves for her attendance at the Licensing In-service Training for Preschool staff held in August, September and October, 2010 and presented by the Ohio Department of Education Office of Early Learning and School Readiness; Payment, at the current tutor rate, to 7 certified staff for their attendance at the Ohio Graduation Test

Preparation/Study Island In-service held on November 3 and 16, 2010; and payment, at the current tutor rate, to 13 certified staff for up to two hours each, for data review of the Ohio Graduation Test Practice results held on December 9, 2010.
